PLEASE proof your entry forms and information very carefully. All changes or mistakes will be charged \$25 for each correction per USTA rule. You CAN NOT put an "X" in any level/event an athlete is not competing in - leave blank.

<u>Entry Deadline</u> Entries must be submitted electronically using the Universal Entry Form and a separate hard copy emailed or mailed to the USTA National Office. Entry and payment must be "IN HAND" by May 5, 2023. Entries received after May 5th will be charged double fees.

NO entries or changes will be accepted after May 17, 2023 (VERY Important).

<u>Admissions:</u> - Tickets for the 2023 USTA Nationals will be available at the venue ONLY. Come the day prior to your scheduled event to purchase your ticket(s) to avoid lines the day of. Tickets will be available for purchase during the Elite Open Work-out June 18 from 6-8 p.m. Competitors do not need admission tickets as long as they have their athlete credential.

Event Parking: Venue is an All Around Facility - Parking Deck fees are \$1/hour or \$7/day.

<u>Flight Awards</u>: Medals will be presented in the competition area as quickly as possible after each flight finishes their competition. Flights will be in groups of 10 or less. Please tell your athletes to stay with their flight until after awards are presented.

Athlete Awards For Those Finishing 1st- 10th: Flight scores will be combined by age group & level to determine the top 10 places. These athletes will then receive trophies in the Award Room after all the flights in a group are completed and computed. 1st-5th Large Trophies, 6th-10th Small Trophies. Competition attire must be worn during the award ceremonies.

<u>Finals:</u> Finals will be held for all advanced, age group elite, and elite events except Synchro Trampoline. The top 10 individuals qualify to advance to finals.

<u>Team Awards:</u> 1st - 3rd Large Trophies

Each team will automatically be entered into all Team Awards they will be eligible for. To be eligible your team must have at least 3 girls or 2 boys in the level of the event entered. Team awards must be picked up at the event.

Top Team Awards: 1st - 3rd Large Trophies and Display Banners

Each team will automatically be entered into Top Team Awards in events entered. Top Team awards must be picked up at the event.

Overall Age Elite Award: 1st-3rd Large Trophies and Display Banners

Your team must have a current USTA Club membership and have Age Elite competitors in all three events of tumbling, trampoline and double-mini trampoline. NO EXTRA FEE TO ENTER. Although preliminary scores are used for the Overall Age Elite Award, an athlete's points will not be awarded for their team if the athlete does not participate in finals unless there is only one athlete in the group, a documented injury, illness, family emergency, etc.

<u>Awards Presentations:</u> Athletes MUST be in competition attire (no warm-ups) to receive their awards on the awards stand. All awards will be given out in the awards area. Awards must be picked up within 24 hours after the last event competed or the award will be forfeited.

<u>Credentials:</u> All competitors and coaches will be issued credentials to enter the coliseum and the competition floor. Each team will receive one coach's credential. Additional coach credentials will be given for teams with over 10 events (1 coach per 10 events). All coaches must be listed on the entry form with their USTA coach numbers. Coaches must also wear their USTA coaches credential to be allowed on the floor.

<u>Competition Attire:</u> During stretch-out, athletes may wear competition warm-ups (which must be stored in a designated area or bag) over their competition attire. Athletes must be in competition attire from the beginning of their warm-up through the presentation of their flight's awards (unless the Superior Judge rules otherwise). Second warning will result in disqualification.

Athletes are allowed to wear slide sandals on the competition floor without deduction.

<u>Advanced</u>, <u>Age Elite and Elite Open</u> athletes are allowed to wear their team warm-ups or USTA national team warm-ups on the competition floor while waiting in line.

THE VENUE HAS A POLICY REGARDING GLITTER! If glitter is worn, it MUST be applied outside the "Premises." Application of glitter inside any room at the "Premises" is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. If glitter becomes a clean-up issue, you will be charged for such clean-up.

<u>Coach & Athlete Attire:</u> Coaches & Athletes MUST be dressed in proper attire (<u>refer to coach & athlete attire rules in handbook</u>) & coaches must wear their current coaching ID with their National coach credential so it is visible to be allowed on the floor. NO EXCEPTIONS.

NOTE: Coaches MUST be in proper Coaches' attire during the Age-Elite - Elite Open work-out.

Protests: Meet Protest Fee is \$100.

GRISWOLD-NISSEN CUP AWARD

The Griswold-Nissen Cup Award was established by Mr. George Nissen and Mr. Larry Griswold, who both pioneered the sport of Trampolining in the 1930's and 1940's, to honor a young man or woman for their excellence in the sports of Trampoline, Tumbling, and Double Mini-Tramp. Nominations for this coveted award, which is presented at the USTA Age-Group National Championship, are made by the USTA coaches throughout the United States. The minimum age to be nominated for the Nissen-Griswold Cup is 15 years old.

USTA PRESIDENTIAL AWARD

The USTA Presidential Award was established by the Executive Board to recognize outstanding coaching. Nominations for USTA coaches in good standing are made by coaches in the USTA

KEVIN BALLENGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS (Two \$500 Scholarships)

The USTA Kevin Ballenger Memorial Scholarship was established by an anonymous donor in memory of Kevin Ballenger, a past USTA competitor, coach, and Technical Board member. Eligible coaches will select a recipient from outstanding graduating high school senior or college athletes nominated each year at the National Championship. Nominees must compete at Nationals the nomination year.

ATHLETE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (One \$500 Scholarship)

The USTA Athlete Memorial Scholarship was established by the USTA in memory of past USTA athletes. Eligible coaches will select a recipient from outstanding graduating high school seniors or college athletes nominated each year at the National Championship. Nominees must be in good standing with the USTA and compete at Nationals the nomination year. The number of awards presented will be determined by the Executive Board.

NTJC SCHOLARSHIP (Two \$500 Scholarships)

The National Trampoline and Tumbling Judges' Association Scholarship was established in 1997 for USTA Competitors. The NTJC Judges will select two recipients from outstanding graduating high school seniors or college/continuing education program athletes nominated each year at the National Championship. Nominees must be in good standing with the USTA and compete at Nationals the nomination year.

NTJC JUDGE OF THE YEAR

The NTJC Judge of the Year will be selected from nominees by the eligible USTA and NTJC members present at the NTJC Meeting during the National Championship.

This will be a yearly award. Criteria for this award:


- 1. Dedication to the sport of Tumbling & Trampoline.

- 3. Great desire. Doesn't quit trying.
- 4. Great personality.
- 5. Be a graduating senior or attending college.

Nominations must include the athlete's name, picture, number of years in the sport of tumbling and trampoline, a description of the athlete's personality, and plans for their education.

<u>DENNIS HARGET</u> MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Dennis Harget was one of the founders of the USTA. He and George Nissen, founder of our sport of Trampoline and Tumbling, worked together with other prominent coaches to bring the USTA to where it is today. Through his determination and by the free clinics he provided, Dennis helped to bring a number of states into the newly formed USTA including Ohio, Kentucky, Indiana, West Virginia, and part of Michigan. Dennis has been honored by the USTA for his hard work and dedication as a two-time recipient of the Presidential Coach of the Year Award and is in the USTA Hall of Fame. He was inducted into the Hamilton Athlete Hall of Fame and recognized by the mayor in a Proclamation for Dennis Harget Day for his contributions to the community.



In remembrance of Dennis, we are honored to award one scholarship each year in the amount of \$500. The scholarship will be awarded during THE PARADE OF CHAMPIONS each year until the scholarship fund has expired. The check will be written payable to the athlete's parent or legal guardian if the athlete is under age 18 or to the athlete if age 18 or older.

Scholarship Criteria:

- 1. Person receiving this award must be at least 15 years of age or above and have been in good standings with the USTA for a minimum of 3 straight years. This is what Dennis would love. He always gave a helping hand to anyone in need to further our sport.
- 2. Coaches may only apply for the scholarship nominating one athlete from their team or club.
- 3. Applicant must send a typed written document explaining the 4 D's and how it relates to their involvement with the USTA, along with a head shot picture in this document.
- 4. Please explain each category of the 4 D's in 100 typed written words or less (400 words total) as how it pertains to their involvement in the USTA.
- 5. The 4 D'S are: (treat each of these as separate topics to be defined in typed or written words).
 - a. DEDICATION
 - b. DETERMINATION
 - c. DESIRE
 - d. DRIVE
- 6. In your nomination, please include the following: Child's name, age, address, and phone number. Parent or Legal guardian's Name, address, and phone number. We need this information to award checks to the recipients.
- 7. Money awarded should be used for classes, entry fees, uniforms, clinics, traveling expenses, and training within the USTA.

She had a way of making those around her laugh and feel less nervous. As a Jr. Coach, Janae was creative in how she reached each and every one of her athletes to make them feel loved and helped them to shine bright. January 27, 2021, Janae was killed on icy roads on her way to college. Even though she is in Heaven now, we will always remember how she lit up the room.
