I was on the USTA Elite National Team for 6 years and was also awarded the athlete of the year on trampoline and DM in 2003 and Trampoline again in 2004. I have won the Kevin Ballinger scholarship and the NTJC scholarship in the past.

I retired from competing in 2005 and pursued coaching. In 2008 I bought TNT Gym from David Pollitte in Kentucky and renamed it to Dynamite Twisters. I am the current head coach and owner of Dynamite Twisters in Morehead, KY.

I am a single mother of 2 little girls age 6, and 8 that are striving every day to become USTA Elite level athletes and follow in their mamas footsteps. I have taught them what the USTA has taught me. To be a team player with good sportsmanship, and to be honest, caring, and respectful. One very interesting fact about me is that I have only missed one national competition since my very first nationals in 1991.

I have coached all levels of athletes from Sub-Beginner through Elite. I have also coached several athletes that were on the USTA National Team. I currently host around 3 competitions each season in the state of Kentucky. I am also the current KY State Chair.

I have worked very hard to get where I am today, and I would not be the coach or person I am today without the USTA. I hope to be able to achieve this goal and help inspire and lead other athletes with this same goal.
